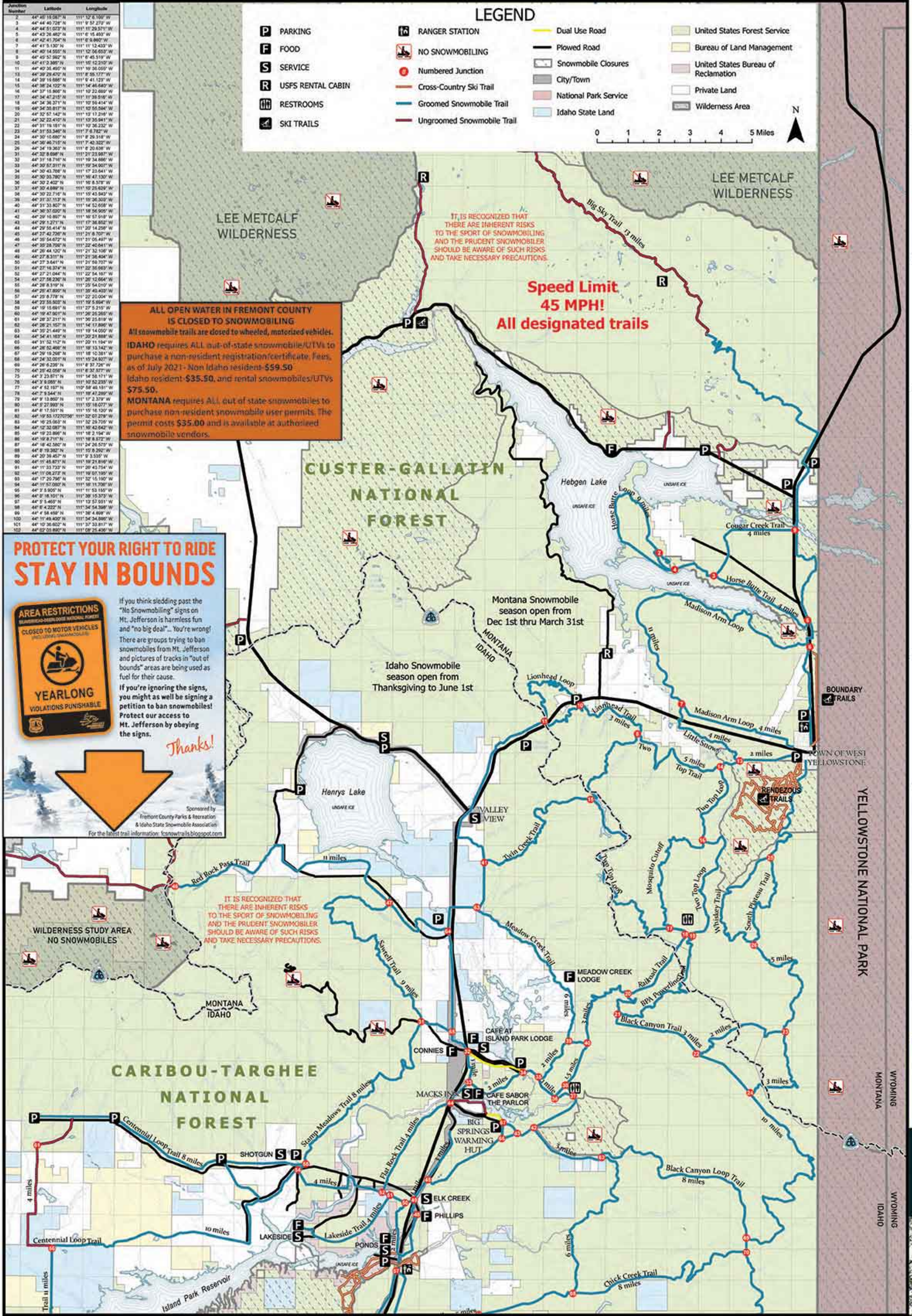

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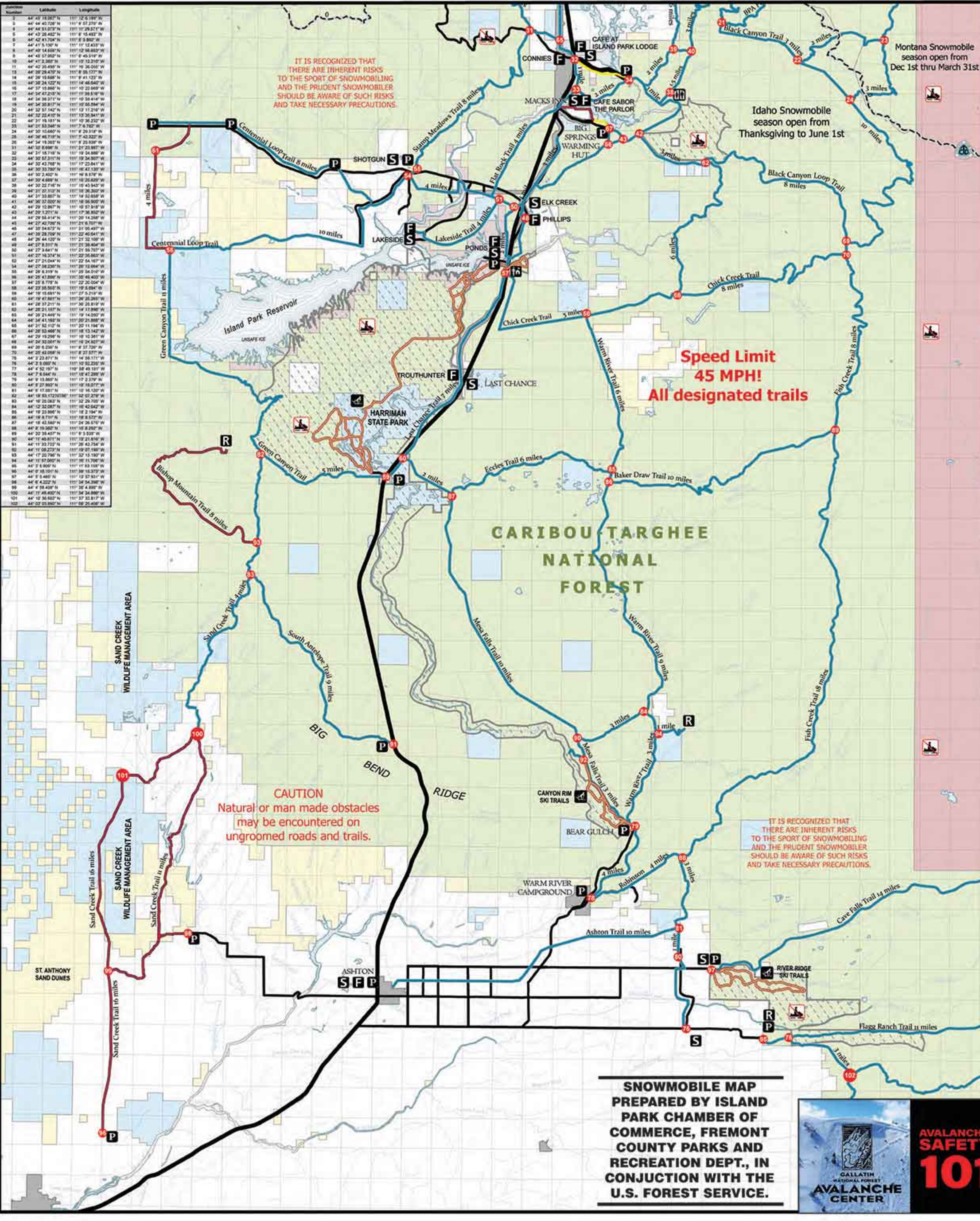
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WELCOME TO THE ASHTON/ISLAND PARK & WEST YELLOWSTONE AREA

SNOWMOBILING

Snowmobile trails in the Ashton/Island Park area of the Caribou-Targhee National Forest in Idaho connect with snowmobile trails in the West Yellowstone area of Custer-Gallatin National Forest in Montana to form one of the largest snowmobile trail systems in the western United States.

400 miles of snowmobile trails in the Ashton/Island Park area are groomed by Fremont County, Idaho and 400 miles of snowmobile trails are groomed in the West Yellowstone area by the West Yellowstone Chamber of Commerce Grooming Committee. Money from snowmobile registrations is the major source of funds for the grooming program.

CROSS-COUNTY SKIING

Over 50 km of cross-country ski trails are groomed by the Ashton/Island Park Ranger District of the Caribou-Targhee National Forest at Buffalo/Brimstone, Canyon Rim, and Fall River Ridge. These trails are a part of the Idaho Department of Parks & Recreation Park 'N' Ski Program.

Over 50 km of cross-country ski trails are groomed by the West Yellowstone Ski Education Foundation at the Rendezvous Trails. The 5 km Boundary Trail is groomed by Hebgen Lake Ranger District of the Custer-Gallatin National Forest.

There is no fee to cross county ski the Boundary Trail. Rendezvous Trails have a daily fee or annual pass.

DESIGNATE FREMONT COUNTY AS YOUR RIDING AREA OF CHOICE

Idaho State Law requires ALL resident and out-of-state snowmobilers, UTVs and other authorized even-snow vehicles used on groomed trails to purchase a registration permit.

Registrations are available at local vendors, DMVs, Idaho State Parks, and online.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- Speed limit 45 miles per hour.
- Stay on designated trails while traveling through restricted areas.
- All open water in Fremont County Idaho are closed to snowmobiling.
- All snowmobile trails are closed to Motorized Wheeled Vehicles.
- Pack out all litter.
- Be aware of oncoming traffic - keep right - two way traffic.
- DONT DRINK & DRIVE.
- Beware of moose, elk, and bison trails.

SAFETY REMINDERS

- Operate at safe speeds.
- Keep to the right on trails.
- Leave trip plan with friend or relative.
- Check weather forecast.
- Adequately dress for the conditions.
- Stay off plowed roads with snowmobiling.
- Beware of hazards along trails, including fences, downed trees, cattle guards, plowed roads, creek crossings, rocks and large animals such as elk and moose.

TRAIL ETIQUETTE

Winter trails within Fremont County are used by a range of visitors including snowmobilers, cross-country skiers, snowshoers, and people just enjoying the winter scenery of this part of Idaho. Consideration for others and protecting our natural resources is extremely important, both for your safety and for the continued enjoyment of the area. You can do your part by following these guidelines:

- Trails have been designated specifically for snowmobilers with ORANGE diamond blazes and cross-country skiers with BLUE diamond blazes. Be courteous by keeping snowmobiles off the marked ski trails and out of closure areas.
- Do not snowmobile over the tops of small trees. This damages the growing portion of the tree.
- Help preserve the beauty of the area by remembering to pack out everything you bring in.
- Respect Private Property

IDAHO law requires ALL out-of-state snowmobile/UTVs to purchase a Non-resident registration/certificate. Non Idaho resident-\$59.50 Idaho Resident-\$35.50, & Rental snowmobiles/UTVs \$75.50.

GET THE FORECAST

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

BEFORE YOU GO

GET THE GEAR: Ensure everyone has an avalanche transceiver, shovel, and probe on their person and knows how to use them. Gear can find your body, partners can save your life.

GET THE TRAINING: Take a field based avalanche course, practice with your equipment. Access information & continue your learning.

EVERYDAY OUT

GET THE FORECAST: Make a plan based on the current avalanche and weather forecast, choose terrain to match conditions and your group's ability. Know what resources exist.

GET THE PICTURE: Know where avalanches happen, travel one at a time on steep slopes and in avalanche paths! Look for obvious signs of instability to dial back your plans like: recent avalanches, signs of unstable snow (cracking & collapsing snowpack), heavy snowfall or rain, windblown snow or rapid thawing.
