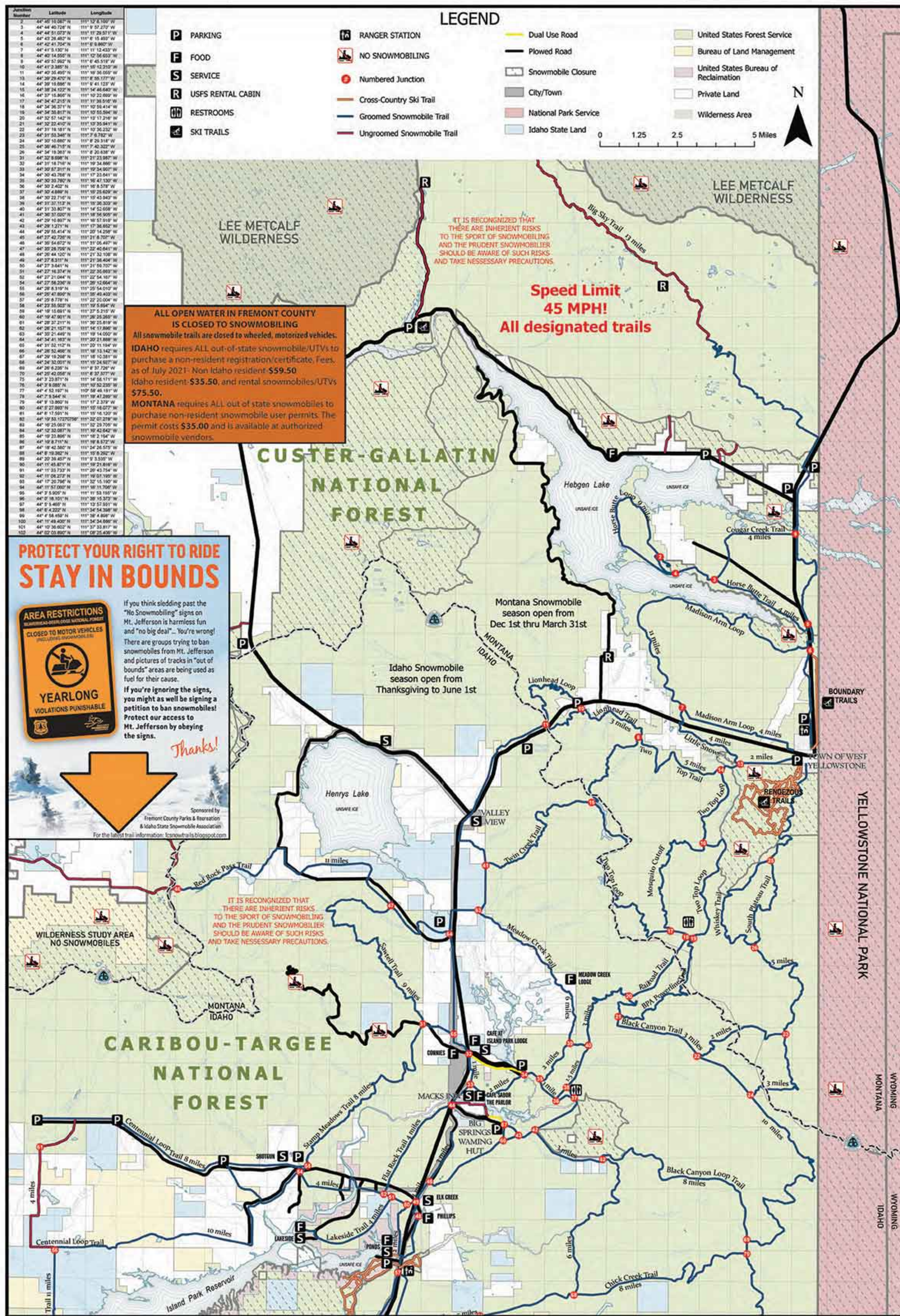

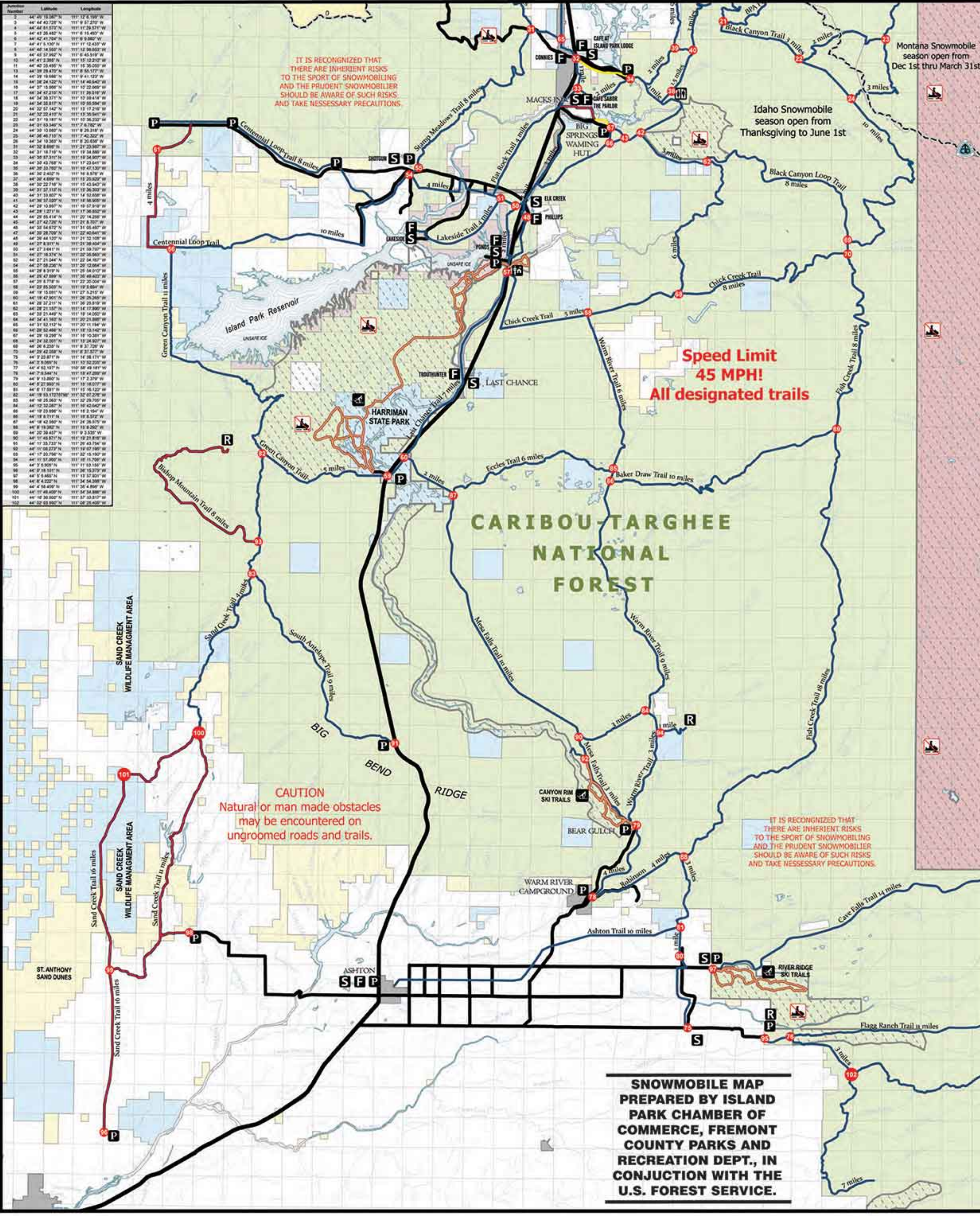

WELCOME TO THE ASHTON/ISLAND PARK & WEST YELLOWSTONE AREA

SNOWMOBILING
 Snowmobile trails in the Ashton/Island Park area of the Caribou-Targhee National Forest in Idaho connect with snowmobile trails in the West Yellowstone area of Custer-Gallatin National Forest in Montana to form one of the largest snowmobile trail systems in the western United States.

400 miles of snowmobile trails in the Ashton/Island Park area are groomed by Fremont County, Idaho and 400 miles of snowmobile trails are groomed in the West Yellowstone area by the West Yellowstone Chamber of Commerce Grooming Committee. Money from snowmobile registrations is the major source of funds for the grooming program.

CROSS COUNTRY SKIING
 Over 50 km of cross country ski trails are groomed by the Ashton/Island Park Ranger District of the Caribou-Targhee National Forest at Buffalo/Brimstone, Canyon Rim, and Fall River Ridge. These trails are a part of the Idaho Department of Parks & Recreation Park "N" Ski Program.

Over 50 km of cross country ski trails are groomed by the West Yellowstone Ski Education Foundation at the Rendezvous Trails. The 5 km Boundary Trail is groomed by Hebgen Lake Ranger District of the Custer-Gallatin National Forest.

There is no fee to cross country ski the Boundary Trail. Rendezvous Trails have a daily fee or annual pass.

DESIGNATE FREMONT COUNTY AS YOUR RIDING AREA OF CHOICE
 Idaho State Law requires ALL snowmobilers, UTVs and other authorized over-snow vehicles used on groomed trails. Idaho State Law requires ALL out-of-state snowmobilers/UTV's to purchase a non-resident registration/certificate.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES

- Speed limit 45 miles per hour.
- Stay on designated trails while traveling through restricted areas.
- ALL open water in Fremont County Idaho are closed to snowmobiling.
- All snowmobile trails are closed to Motorized Wheeled Vehicles.
- Pack out all litter.
- Be aware of oncoming traffic - keep right - two way traffic.
- DO NOT DRINK & DRIVE.
- Beware of moose, elk, and bison trails.

SAFETY REMINDERS

- Operate at safe speeds.
- Keep to the right on trails.
- Leave big plans with friend or relative.
- Check weather forecast.
- Adequately dress for the conditions.
- Stay off plowed roads with snowmobiling.
- Beware of hazards along trails, including fences, downed trees, cattle guards, plowed roads, creek crossings, rocks and large animals such as elk and moose.

TRAIL ETIQUETTE
 Winter trails within Fremont County are used by a range of visitors including snowmobilers, cross-country skiers, snowshoers, and people just enjoying the winter scenery of this part of Idaho. Consideration for others and protecting our natural resources is extremely important, both for your safety and for the continued enjoyment of the area. You can do your part by following these guidelines.

- Trails have been designated specifically for snowmobilers with ORANGE diamond blazes and cross-country skiers with BLUE diamond blazes. Be courteous by keeping snowmobiles off the marked ski trails and out of closure areas.
- Do not snowmobile over the tops of small trees. This damages the growing portion of the tree.
- Help preserve the beauty of the area by remembering to pack out everything you bring in.
- Respect Private Property.

AVAILANCHE
 Avalanche danger cannot be taken too seriously because a wall of moving, suffocating snow leaves few survivors in its wake. The best way to avoid an avalanche is to be knowledgeable of avalanche conditions and reroute your trip to avoid them. Avalanches occur when loose snow or a slab of snow starts moving down a slope. Avalanches are triggered by a variety of slope, snow and weather conditions; many times they are triggered by human impact. Slope conditions to watch out for are steep slopes or smooth, open slopes. Short slopes can be as dangerous as long ones. Leeward slopes are dangerous because wind-deposited snow adds depth and may create unstable slabs of snow.

Avoid avalanches by staying away from mountainous terrain after heavy snowfall or prolonged periods of high wind. Avoid crossing steep slope hills or entering narrow, steeply sided canyons. The safest routes are on ridgetops and on the windward side, away from cornices. The next safest route is out in the valley, far from the bottom of a slope.

AVAILANCHE SURVIVAL

If you are caught in an avalanche:
 • Call out to other members of your party can track your location.
 • Discard all equipment and get away from your snowmobile.
 • Make swimming motions and try to stay on top; work your way to the side of the avalanche.
 • As you feel the avalanche slow, try to thrust your hand or any other part of your body above the surface.
 • Before the snow settles, slip your arm in front of your face to clear an air space.
 • Try not to panic; you need to preserve oxygen.

If you are a survivor, you are a victim's best hope of survival:
 • Mark the place where you last saw the victim and keep your eyes fixed on the moving mass of snow in which he is trapped.
 • Search for the victim directly down-slope from the last sighted area when the snow stops moving. Use a ski pole or stick to probe the snow.
 • Stay with the victim unless help is only a few minutes away; after 30 minutes, the victim has only a 50 percent chance of survival.
 • If the victim is found, treat for hypothermia, suffocation and shock.
